

NOTIFICATION: DSB UAT - Reset Password Functionality now available

Audience: All DSB GUI Users

The purpose of this note is to inform DSB GUI users that the Reset Password functionality is now available on UAT.

Notification details:

The Reset Password functionality has been activated on 27 May 2018. This function will allow the user to reset their password if they have forgotten it without the need to contact the DSB Technical Support.

The Reset Password function is tentatively scheduled for Production on 1st July 2018 and will be sent on a separate notification while we await feedback on UAT.
