The purpose of this note is to inform DSB users that the **FIX UAT services** will be put in maintenance early this weekend due to routine maintenance being carried out. This work will be starting at **02:00 AM UTC Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> July** and will finish at the usual time of **12:00 PM UTC Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> July**.

**This does not affect the Production maintenance window which is scheduled every week from 12:00pm UTC Saturday to 12:00pm UTC Sunday**

### **Action Required:**

- DSB UAT FIX endpoint will be put in maintenance this time and will not be accessible during maintenance.
- REST and GUI will remain accessible during the FIX UAT maintenance and will follow the regular weekly maintenance.
