NOTIFICATION: DSB UAT2 Early Weekend Maintenance Schedule for 28th August 2021

Audience: All DSB users

Notification details:

The purpose of this notification is to inform DSB users that the DSB **UAT2** services will be on an early maintenance schedule on 28th August 2021. This extended maintenance period is required to allow ample time for the DSB component update.

This does NOT affect the UAT and Production maintenance window which is scheduled every week from 12:30 PM UTC Sunday to 00:30 AM UTC Sunday.

UAT2 Implementation Timeline:

Early Weekend Maintenance Schedule for 28th August 2021: 12:00 AM UTC Saturday 28th August 2021 and will finish at 12:30 PM UTC Sunday 29th August 2021.

Impact to users:

The UAT2 DSB services will be unavailable for an additional period of 24.5 hours.

Action**Required:**

DSB users will need to ensure that they are disconnected from the UAT2 environment before 12:00 AM UTC Saturday 28th August 2021.
