Background	<p>The Full details of this product can be found in the UPI Product Definition Document - Other.Other.Undefined.</p> <p>The PC agreed to the definition of an additional “catch all” template for the purpose of providing universal OTC derivative support to the industry. The PC expressed a preference for the creation of a single template for this function rather than separate templates for each asset class or instrument type.</p> <p>The applicable attributes for this Product Definition template reflects the CFI values as defined in ISO 10962 (CFI Code) – Third edition 2015-07-15 where the following categories and groups are supported.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Category [Instrument Type] <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Swaps • Non-listed and complex listed options • Forwards • Others b. Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The full details of this Product Definition template can be found in the UPI Product Definition Document – Other.Other.Undefined. • The proposed template should support the direct entry of CFI attributes in valid (six character) combinations only – including MMSXXX. • The proposed template should support the entry of CFI attribute names rather than letters. • The proposed template will derive a complete CFI code and FISN. • The proposed template will not support the use of “X” as a substitute CFI value unless that letter is specified in ISO 10962 (CFI). • The proposed template will not support the entry of an Underlier ID or Underlier Type. • The OTC ISIN version of the proposed template will have the same functionality but will, in addition, support the input of an Expiry Date. 		

Impact Details	<p>This is a new UPI Product Definition template where attributes, values and codes are based on ISO 10962 Classification of financial instruments (CFI code) - Third edition 2015-07-15.</p> <p>The new UPI Product Definition template will support all Categories [Instrument Types] and Groups (Asset Classes) and will derive the following values based on the attributes selected.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Derivation of CFI Codes – <i>See UPI Product Definition Document Section 4.2.1</i> User is able to select only one Category [Instrument Type] and Group [Asset Class]. Once Category and Group is selected, the user must select the CFI attributes and values where applicable. Once selected, the returned UPI Record must contain the complete CFI Codes with details provided in Appendix 2 – CFI Codes. b. Derivation of Short Name (FISN) - <i>See UPI Product Definition Document Sections 4.2.2</i> The derived value of Short Name (FISN) is based on the input CFI attributes where applicable abbreviation is provided in Appendix 2 – Short Name (FISN) Abbreviation.
