File download files are specific to each of the DSB's environments and can be found in the following locations:

where **<env>** can be one of:

- PROD for the production environment
- UAT for the next release UAT environment
- UAT2 for the as-production UAT2 environment
- UPIUAT for the UPI UAT environment

Under the main directory structure, users can access Records, Reports and Schemas.

#### 1.1 Records

The Records folder represents the data files produced by the different services. At the time of writing the services offered cover OTC-Products (ISIN, ISIN-migration, ISIN+, UPI, UPI.CUSIP, UPI.FIGI, and UPI.SEDOL records) as well as TOTV records.

The DSB produces a data file with a ".records" extension and a compressed version of this file with a ".zip" extension.

#### 1.1.1 OTC-Products

For OTC-Products, the DSB maintains both daily Delta files for the ISIN, ISIN-migration, ISIN+, UPI, UPI.CUSIP, UPI.FIGI, and UPI.SEDOL service and Snapshot files for the ISIN service.

Within the Delta folders, there are ISIN, ISIN-migration, ISIN+, UPI, UPI.CUSIP, UPI.FIGI, and UPI.SEDOL subfolders.

Each day is then broken down by asset class as follows:

- Commodities
- Credit
- Equity
- Foreign Exchange
- Other
- Rates

Each asset class folder will contain a ".records" and a ".zip" file. The ".records" file contains one or more json records separated by newline ('\n'). The .zip file is a compressed version of the ".records" file.

#### 1.1.1.1 Delta Files

Various Delta files are published daily, including:

- ISIN
- ISIN-migration
- ISIN+
- UPI
- UPI with Alternative Underlying Identifier (UPI.CUSIP, UPI.FIGI, UPI.SEDOL)

These files contain the history of all records (i.e., if an ISIN is created and expired on the same day the ISIN Delta file will contain both the new ISIN record and the expired ISIN record).

Delta files are created if a single record was created or received an update (i.e., expired, deprecated, or migrated) that day.

#### 1.1.1.1.1 ISIN

ISIN Delta files contain ISIN records created, updated, expired, or deprecated during the day.

ISIN Delta files are published at approximately 00:05am UTC every day.

#### 1.1.1.1.2 ISIN-migration

ISIN-migration Delta files contain ISIN records migrated by the pre-population process during the day.

ISIN-migration Delta files are published at approximately 00:05am UTC every day.

#### 1.1.1.1.3 ISIN+

ISIN+ Delta files contain both ISIN and ISIN-migration records during the day.

ISIN+ Delta files are published around 00:50 AM UTC daily.

#### 1.1.1.1.4 UPI

UPI Delta files contain UPI records created or updated during the day.

UPI Delta files are published at approximately 00:05am UTC every day.

The most recent UPI Delta File will be immediately available to fee-paying users (i.e., DSB UPI users that pay for DSB access), DSB UPI registered users will be able to access the file one day after it has been published.

#### 1.1.1.1.5 UPI with Alternative Underlying Identifier (UPI.CUSIP, UPI.SEDOL, UPI.FIGI)

These Delta files contain UPI records with Alternative Underlying Identifiers:

- UPI.CUSIP includes UPI records with CUSIP alternative Underlying identifier
- UPI.FIGI includes UPI records with FIGI alternative Underlying identifier
- UPI.SEDOL includes UPI records with SEDOL alternative Underlying identifier

UPI Delta Files with alternate underliers (e.g., CUSIP, FIGI) are generated and available for fee-paying DSB Users with the appropriate licenses who have been set up in the Client Onboarding and Support Platform (COSP) to access these files.

#### 1.1.1.2 Snapshot Files

Snapshot Files are generated at 16:00 UTC every Sunday and contain all records in the databases in the status that they were at as at the end of the day before (Saturday).

Snapshot Files are currently available for ISIN and will be available for <sup>1</sup>UPI from 19 November 2023.

#### 1.1.2 TOTV

The DSB maintains two versions of files in relation to the Trading On a Trading Venue (ToTV) service:

- V1 TOTV Files with records based on ESMA Financial Instruments Reference Data System (FIRDS).
- **V2** TOTV Files with records containing information from both FCA FIRDS and ESMA FIRDS.

A similar year and day folder structure, as for the OTC-Products, is followed for the TOTV Files. Under the day folder, ToTV zip files identified by an asset class and instrument type code are available.

## 2 Support and Availability

Please note that the DSB's operating hours are available <a href="here">here</a>. Users are advised to adjust their operations, specifically on Sundays for their production systems according to the DSB's current maintenance hours.

The file download structure may contain other directories which are symbolic links into the structure defined above. These links have been provided to users for backward compatibility with previous directory structures of the file download.

When advised, OTC ISIN users should adopt the new file download structure as soon as possible as the links will be not remain indefinitely.

## 3 Automating the file download

#### 3.1 Using Wget

It is possible to access the file download section using ReStful API, <u>cURL</u> command and/or <u>Wget</u> command.

Users should note that they must send basic authentication when accessing the file download.

cURL and Wget are just two of the ways to automate the file-download and are neither developed nor supported by the DSB.

For further instructions please refer to the manual pages of cURL and/or Wget command.
