## 1 Minutes: Review of open actions

- Action 23: Secretariat has requested clarity on approach from ANNA Board on Product Committee recommendations where there may be any "unresolvable points" contradicting the updated Terms of Reference – Product Committee to follow governance and present points to ANNA Board for review. Closed, ToR added to Product Committee Appendices
- Action 26: Secretariat to arrange for ISO representative to present update on CFI work to Product Committee – Date confirmed Tues 14 February 2017. Closed
- Action 27: Product Committee to provide list of questions to be addressed by ISO representative ahead of the meeting Secretariat to circulate initial questions to Product Committee for consideration Initial question set developed. Closed
  - Action: Secretariat to develop and circulate draft ANNA Board Monthly Progress report as required to be completed under the Product Committee Governance Framework for sign off 7 February 2017

#### **2 Product Committee Effectiveness**

- A member outlined the two key areas of focus which was important to reach consensus on in order to satisfy delivery of ISIN's as per MiFID II requirements set out by ESMA:
  - Template Taxonomies
  - ISIN Structure

#### **Template Taxonomies**

- The member reiterated that the design of the ISIN must be extensible for industry beyond the RTS 23 requirement and that it is industry preference to have the choice of either ISO or ISDA taxonomies in selecting and completing templates
- The Product Committee discussed the template for Rates and agreed that the 'Special Feature' (as per SG2) should not be included in the Use Case reference field as that level of granularity is not required for the initial implementation

- The Product Committee agreed the exception was an Amortising Swap which can be identified by 'Notional Schedule' which should be moved to the attribute list for users to populate
  - **Action:** DSB Secretariat to relocate 'Notional Schedule' in the rates template from Derived to Required attributes
- The Product Committee discussed and agreed to increase its scope to provide a mapping from ISDA taxonomy to ISO taxonomy for all relevant RTS23/CFI & FISN attributes within the templates themselves and the template selection
  - Action: ISO CFI to ISDA taxonomy to be provided by ISDA and verified by Product Committee
- The Product Committee agreed to increase its scope to undertake the validation of ISDA taxonomy FpML (Version TBD) attributes to ISO Taxonomy attributes for each product template
  - Action: DSB Technical team to provide their estimate and impact assessment for a service that will translate ISDA Taxonomy v2.0 & FpML (Version TBD) attributes to ISO taxonomy attributes and present to the Product Committee for consideration
- The Product Committee reviewed and agreed the input interface to ISIN Data Engine should allow users the option of two distinct taxonomy templates - ISO based and ISDA/FpML based
- The Product Committee agreed that the output of the ISIN Engine can be solely native ISO for the Day 1 implementation as long as the input could be supplied using ISDA & FpML values. However, the requirement to map the output data attributes from ISO back into FpML should be kept, but as a "nice to have" capability

#### 6 AOB

- The Chair observed that the Product Committee has missed the published timelines for finalisation of Consultation Paper Phase 1
- Committee members discussed an extended timeline for the Product Committee to complete each phase of its work, which given the requirement for thorough analysis, would likely entail extension beyond the start of UAT on 1 April 2017
- A member raised a question of what would be the implications and the possible mitigation plans to reduce the delivery risk of the ISIN UAT
  - Action: Secretariat to revert to ANNA Board on implications and desired mitigation strategy for ISIN UAT scheduled for 1 April 2017
