# 2 Timeline & implementation Model to Support Tenor Calculation for RTS-23. Field 41

- The topic was presented and discussed by the attendees.
- The meeting discussed whether a tenor calculation was desirable in all cases and agreed that a best practice driven approach was the most pragmatic approach given the diversity of member's data and DSB related integration models
- The meeting discussed whether the standardised tenor values should be defined as best practice or embedded in the technical solution and the resulting implications on both participant preferences and DSB delivery timelines to support user testing & go-live.
- The meeting was advised that the proposed timeline for Option 2 (Baseline + Integrated Tenor Calculator) was predicated on the development of a solution based on the previously approved functionality and that any amendment to the requirements would result in delay to the release date.
- The meeting reached a consensus and agreed that in the absence of any message from ESMA recommending a delay to the implementation of the Field 41 requirements the DSB will take the following actions:
  - **Option 0 (Baseline)** 
    - Continue development. Delivery date: 24<sup>th</sup> March 2019.
    - The DSB will require a minimum of one week's notice to roll back this release.
  - Option 1 (Baseline + Utilities)
    - A DSB Tenor Calculator (Excel spreadsheet or other web-based mechanism) will be made available to the user community. Delivery date: 24<sup>th</sup> March 2019.
    - The tenor calculation logic will be made available via the DSB website as soon as possible after 24<sup>th</sup> March 2019. Date to be confirmed.
    - Due to resourcing considerations, the JavaScript source code for the Tenor calculation logic will be made available to the user community if the previously delivered solutions are not deemed sufficient.
  - Option 2 (Baseline + Integrated Tenor Calculator)
    - Continue development of the integrated tenor calculator solution in accordance with the previously agreed specification. Delivery date: 12<sup>th</sup> May 2019.
    - The PC will agree a list of standard tenor values (e.g.: 6M, 1Y, 2Y etc.) for the generation of ISINs that can be submitted to the regulators as best practice for DSB users and to assist industry in supporting data consistency.
    - The DSB will collect and collate proposed standard tenor values (1Y, 2Y etc.).
    - PC and TAC members are to provide feedback on the list of standard tenor values by COB 14<sup>th</sup> February 2019.
    - Any questions raised to the DSB Secretariat are to be forwarded to the trade associations represented at this meeting.
- Action 273 : DSB to collect and collate proposed standard tenor values (1Y, 2Y etc.). These are to be distributed to the members of the PC and TAC and passed directly to the trade associations represented at this meeting.
- Action 274 : DSB to make the Tenor Calculator Spreadsheet available to the PC and TAC membership.
