#### 8 DSB-139 / 1574 : Option Type / Exercise Style

The PC discussed the needed to align the UPI and OTC ISIN templates for Non-Standard Options in relation to the use of the Option Type and Exercise Style attributes, where:

- Option Type and Exercise Style are mandatory attributes in the UPI definitions.
- Option Type and Exercise Style are optional attributes in the OTC ISIN definitions.

The members of the PC were asked to consider the two following options:

Mandatory Attributes Update the OTC ISIN to require the entry of Option Type / Exercise Style for Non-Standard Options.

Optional Attributes Update the UPI to make the entry of Option Type / Exercise Style optional for Non-Standard Options

Members of the PC **APPROVED** option 2 (update the UPI) following a discussion in which it was agreed that the OTC ISINs and UPI for these products would be created with an "X" in Attr#2 of the derived ISO

10962 (CFI) Code. In addition, the members agreed that it would be necessary for the "deprecated" status of these OTC ISINs would need to be reversed through a batch update to the existing records.

The DSB agreed to create a new change request for the implementation of this change and to return to the PC at a later date with an update on the development and deployment plans.

## 9 Credit Index: New Entry Workflow

Following changes to the ownership of IHS Markit, the DSB does not currently have access to the list of IHS Markit Long Name for Credit Index underliers. For this reason, DSB is proposing to introduce a new standard procedure for the addition of Credit Indices to the enumerated list that:

- Responds to the user requirement to support a comprehensive list of underliers.
- Endeavours to ensure that duplicate identifiers are not generated by the system.
- Follows a standard naming convention that is adoptable by the industry.

To that end, the DB presented a proposed workflow to support the addition of new Credit Indices to the enumerated list.

#### 1. Proposed Workflow

The DSB presented a workflow that was based on the receipt of a request for the addition of a new Credit Index from a user and involved verification of the details and presentation to the DSB PC before being released into the production environment as a "Dynamic Enumeration" change.

Member of the PC **APPROVED** the proposed approach for the addition of Credit Indices to the DSB enumerated list. The DSB will follow this procedure for the addition of CDX.EM.HY and CDX.EM.IG into the enumerated list.
